

WHAT'S THE COST OF TREATING MY SLEEP APNEA?

The Assistive Devices Program (ADP) in Ontario states that ALL vendors MUST supply a patient with:

A CPAP machine with humidifier, hose and MASK for \$860.00

ADP pays 75% of the cost or \$645.00 directly to the vendor you purchase your CPAP machine from. ADP will provide funding once every five years.

You pay \$215.00.

NOTE - If you require a speciality mask i.e. nasal pillows or a full face mask there may be an additional fee.

Many insurance companies cover this cost and the cost of future supplies.

CONTACT your insurance company and ASK the following:

1. What's covered at time of purchase and how much?
 - A. What about an extra mask, filters or hose at time of purchase?
 - B. Extended warranty?
 - C. Chin or mask straps?
 - D. Compliance package?
2. What coverage exists for future replacement of masks, filters, hoses etc.
3. What information and/or forms do they require for payment (i.e. paid invoice, prescription, ADP form)
